## WHAT'S COVERED?

- **1.** Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) Cardiac arrest is a leading cause of death. CPR manually preserves brain function until further help is available to restore blood circulation and breathing. How to do it
- 2. Automated External Defibrillator (AED) An AED delivers an electric shock to the heart to end arrhythmia. The body's natural pacemaker then re-establishes normal rhythm. An AED can make the difference between life and death. How to use one
- **3. Choking**: Find out about airway obstruction and signs and symptoms of choking. **What to do**
- 4. Severe bleeding: Bleeding is usually minor but threatens life if severe. What to do
